

TRESPASS WARNING FORM
TRESPASSING ON THE LAND OF ANOTHER

- a. No person shall intentionally trespass on the land of another and, without claim of right, refuse to depart there from on demand of the lawful possessor thereof or his agent. A demand to depart may be made as follows:
 - 1) Orally, or in writing, by the lawful possessor or the possessor's agent; or,
 - 2) By conspicuously posting at reasonable intervals signs which prohibit trespass on the affected lane; or,
 - 3) By conspicuously posting at reasonable intervals signs which prohibit trespass on the affected land during certain hours.

- b. No person who has received a written demand to depart pursuant to clause (1) of paragraph (a) of this section shall reenter the lawful possessor's land without the written permission of the lawful possessor or the agent providing said demand for a period up to one (1) year from the date of the written demand, as provided therein.

A building owner can authorize the **Chaska Police Department** to enforce the trespassing ordinance by signing an affidavit to the effect.
